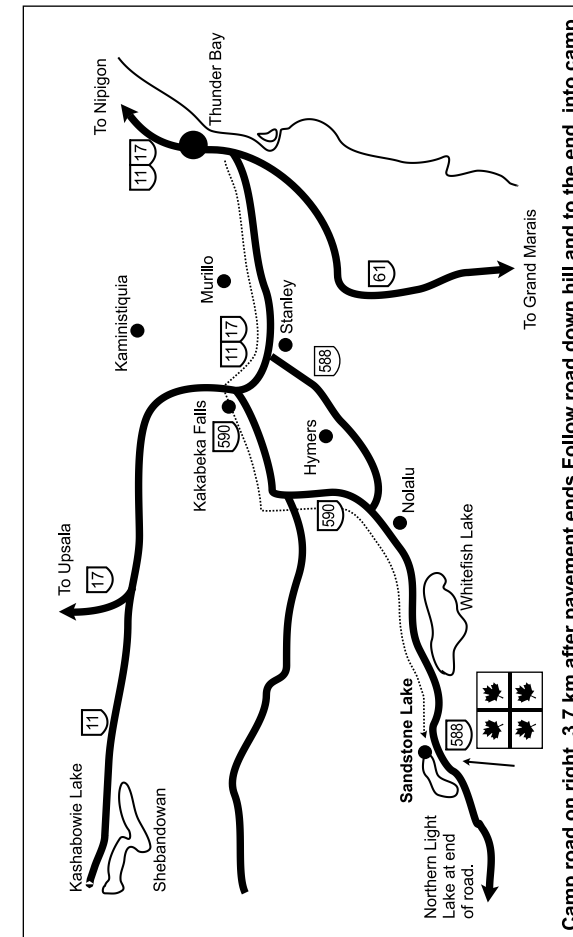

JUNIOR, INTERMEDIATE, SENIOR & YOUTH:

Christian Program: "Kid-friendly" Bible Studies and worship are led by the Spiritual Director.

Swimming: Our beautiful cove is safe for campers and staff under the supervision of qualified lifeguards.

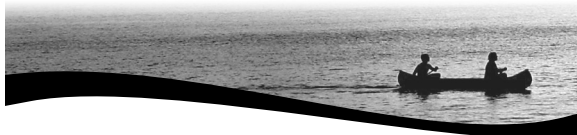
Canoeing: Learn basic canoe and safety skills in a shallow sandy cove.

Crafts: are geared to age. All supplies are provided.

Meals and Snacks: A healthy menu is provided. Please notify us early of special needs and allergies. We are fish and peanut-free. Fridge space is provided for special diets required for medical purposes.

Health Care Services: Provided by a First Aider or R.N.. We contact you to pick up a sick camper, but we do transport in emergencies. We require a complete and signed Health Form for each camper. Health forms will be mailed when registration is received.

ALL-INCLUSIVE RATE

The fee includes 7 days and 6 nights of accommodations, meals, fun activities like swim, sports, crafts, canoe, campfire, tuck and a bus ride back to Thunder Bay. There are no additional charges at the camp for anything.

FEES: \$185 per camper (by June 1, 2010)
\$200 per camper (after June 1, 2010)

A payment schedule can be arranged with the Registrar, but full payment is required at least two weeks before camp begins.

CANCELLED REGISTRATIONS

Refunds are at the discretion of the Executive Committee and subject to a \$25 administration fee.

BURSARIES

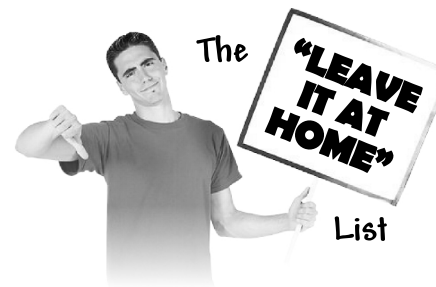
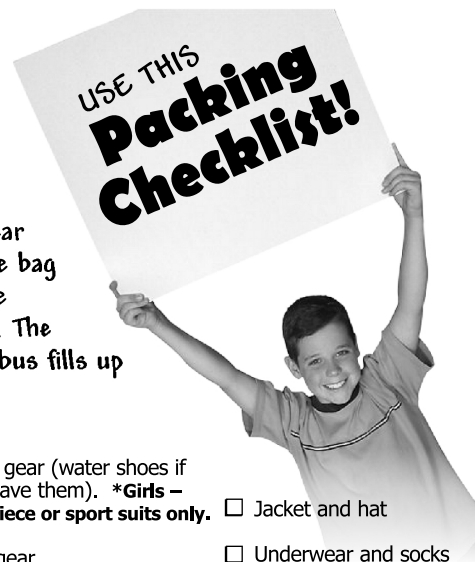
Costs Subsidised

Registration Fee covers less than 50% of actual costs. Anglican Churches generously support this mission throughout the year with money, volunteer labour and prayer. Watch for fundraisers throughout the year. Help is always welcome!

Our camp drinking water system report for 2009 is available upon request.

Please pack gear into one bag and one bedroll. The return bus fills up fast!

- Swim gear (water shoes if you have them). *Girls – one piece or sport suits only.
- Rain gear
- Soap, face cloth, towels (one for beach)
- Shampoo, comb / brush
- Toothbrush & paste, cup with name
- Non-aerosol insect repellent
- Water-repellant sunscreen
- Flashlight & fresh batteries
- Shorts and T-shirts
- Long pants and long sleeved shirt
- Health Form, if not mailed in
- Jacket and hat
- Underwear and socks
- Water bottle, labeled with name *MUST BRING*
- Spare shoes
- Warm sleeping bag OR warm blankets, single sheet and pillow
- Log medallions from previous years
- Bible (available at camp for those with none)
- Optional stuff: costume, camera/film, stuffed mascot, instruments, mask, snorkel
